Discerning False Teaching

The Ten Marks of a Cult

A cult is organized heresy. It is a religious movement that twists orthodox faith turning truth into lies. Absolute devotion to the twisted truth and the movement's leader is required. A cult can be discerned by examination through the following filters:

- 1. Fictitious Scripture What does this group teach about the Bible or extra-revelation?
- **2. Fallible Theology** What does this group teach about God? about the Trinity? about the Holy Spirit?
- **3. Flawed Christology –** What does this group teach about Jesus?
- **4. Faulty Doctrine** What doctrine does this group teach about sin? about salvation? about the security of the believer? about Israel?
- 5. Feeble Hope What does this group teach about the after-life? about Heaven? about Hell?
- **6. Forceful Organizational Structure –** What does this group teach about the authority of their organization? about the Church? about the ordinances of the Church?
- **7. Fabricated Innovations** What does this group teach about the experiences of Christians? about the normal Christian life?
- **8. Filtered Syncretism** What does this group teach about assimilating the doctrines of other groups?
- **9. Fraudulent Monetary Exploitation** What does this group teach about finances? about financial extravagances of the leadership?
- **10. Flagrant Denunciation of Others –** What does this group communicate in their attitudes toward other believers? toward other churches?
